(Bloomberg) -- Philippine peso advances as the central bank governor calls for calm after the currency fell on Friday to its lowest since 2006.

\* Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas Governor Nestor Espenilla called for calm on Sunday after the peso fell to an almost 11-year low against the dollar last week, saying the currency isn't expected to free-fall given the nation's strong economic fundamentals

\* Traders for the Philippine peso will probably be cautious after Espenilla's comment about free-fall, according to Colin Rodriguez, senior vice president at Rizal Commercial Banking

\* USD/PHP falls 0.1% to 50.920

\* Philippine Finance Secretary Carlos Dominguez open to dropping 10-peso per liter levy on sugar-sweetened beverage estimated to generate 47b pesos in first year of implementation provided rest of tax reform package proposed by Senate President Koko Pimentel intact, Inquirer reports

\* Treasury to auction PHP6b of 91-day bills, PHP5b of 182-day bills and PHP4b of 364-day bills Monday

\* Global funds were net buyers of \$3.3m in local equities on Aug. 10: exchange data

\* Yield on 3.625% govt bonds due in September 2025 steady at 4.50%, according to Tradition pricing
