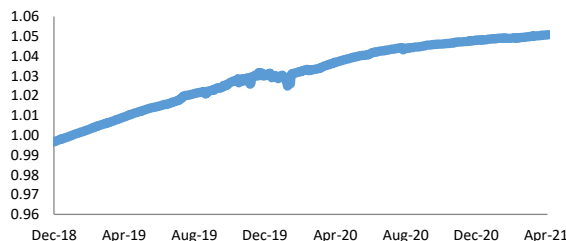

MARKET COMMENTARY

Government Securities yields (-1.35bps on avg.) ended mixed last week, trading in a tight range ahead of April inflation data (May 5) and BTr's 5yr auction (May 4). Demand remains to be in the front-end of the curve spilling over to the 5-7y space.

Yields will continue to trade in a tight range in the near-term leading up to CPI and GDP data as interest continues to remain mixed. Players will look to global market developments for directional cues.

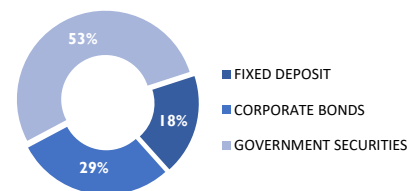
